- 24.2 The Principal is not authorized to admit students who are proven guilty of vandalizing the college or destroying college property and those who are certified accused of ragging. In the context of ragging. G.C. Memorandum no. It is mandatory to follow the guidelines of F-1-16/2007 (CPP II) April 2009. In this regard, letter no. issued by the department. As per letter No. 829/469/Aushi/Sha-1/08 dated 18 June 2008, Zero Tolerance Policy will remain in force.
- 24.3 Transgenders will be given admission only in co-educational colleges.
- 24.4 Full-time government/non-government serving employees are not eligible for regular admission in the college which is taken during their daily working hours. But if the applicant applies for admission in a college after the daily duty period, admission can be given only after the applicant presents the no objection certificate from the employer.
- 25. Admission rules for out-of-state applicants:-

25.1

- Up to graduation level B.A/B.Com/B.Sc. / B.Sc. With the implementation of integrated course in (Home Science), applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from any university/autonomous college of the state are eligible for admission in the next year/semester, but the subjects/groups of subjects being taught in the concerned university/autonomous college. If the applicants have appeared in the previous examination, then regular admission can be given only after the relevant test.
- 25.2 UGC located outside the state of Madhya Pradesh. Applicants who have passed first/second year or second/fourth semester examination of graduation level from universities/autonomous colleges recognized by the State, first and second semester examination of post-graduation from other universities/autonomous colleges of the state and first/second year examination of bachelor of law level will be eligible for their After submitting the eligibility certificate from the respective universities, regular admission can be given in case of vacancy in the next class of the same subject/subjects/group of subjects.
- 25.3 Students from outside the state will have to give an affidavit in the prescribed format. In case any fake or false/incorrect information is found in the affidavit, the admission of the concerned student will be canceled and he/she will be deprived of admission in any university of the state for the next three years.
- 25.4 Before admission of students from outside the state, it is mandatory for the principals to get police verification done through the respective state and local police centers.
- 25.5 The system of reserving 80 percent seats for students of Madhya Pradesh and 20 percent for students of other states will be applicable in higher education institutions subsidized by the Central Government.
- 25.6 It is mandatory for the students wishing to take admission in the college to submit the character certificate issued by the Principal of the institution in which they previously studied.
- 25.7 Students from other states can be given admission in the subjects in which sufficient number of students from the state are not available for admission.

#### 26. Reservation:-

According to the reservation policy of Madhya Pradesh Government, reservation will be as follows:-

- 26.1 If any candidate of reserved category appears in the merit list as per rules in general category/open competition due to scoring more marks, then the seats of reserved category will remain unaffected. But if such a student belongs to any other cadre like freedom fighter etc. then the seat of the concerned cadre will be considered filled in that specific reserved category. The remaining seats of the respective specific cadre will be filled as per eligibility.
- 26.2 16 percent and 20 percent seats will be reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC) and Scheduled Tribe (ST) applicants respectively. The places of these two classes will be interchangeable.

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- 26.3 14 percent seats will be reserved for applicants from backward classes (except creamy layer). (Madhya Pradesh Amendment number 13681 227 Twenty-one A (P) Adhikari published in Gazette Number 349 Bhopal dated 14.08.2019. On the amended order dated 13.08.2019, petition number W.P. Will be implemented under the decision passed by the Honorable High Court under No. 5901/2019)
- 26.4 Sons/daughters and grandsons/grandsons of freedom fighters, sons/daughters of soldiers martyred while on duty in the Indian Army or permanently disabled and dependents of former and serving Army personnel. / 05 percent seats will be reserved jointly for the children of Central Arm Police Force and for the disabled category applicants of these categories. The combined ranking of the three categories should be determined by giving a surcharge of 10 percent marks to the applicants belonging to the disabled category, but this reservation will be provided only from the places reserved for the concerned cadre. The order of priority of Indian Armed Forces personnel/officers will be as follows -
  - 1. Widows of martyrs and their dependents during the war.
  - 2. Permanently disabled during war, serving soldiers and their dependents.
  - 3. Dependents of martyrs during service during peace.
  - 4. Persons permanently disabled during service during peace and their dependents.
  - 5. Dependents of serving or ex-servicemen awarded with the following gallantry medals Param Vir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, Best War Service Medal, Mahavir Chakra, Kirti Chakra, Best Service Medal, Veer Chakra, Shaurya Chakra, War Service Medal, Army, Navy / Air Mention in army medal letters.
  - 6. President's Police Medal for Gallantry.
  - 7. Dependents of ex-servicemen.
  - 8. Dependents of serving soldiers.
- 26.5 5 percent seats will be reserved for disabled category applicants, but this reservation will be provided only from the seats reserved for the concerned cadre. Disabled persons will be given 5 percent relaxation in qualifying marks at the time of admission. Disabled applicants can avail the benefit of this category if they upload the certificate issued in the prescribed format provided by the District Medical Board (which mentions 40 percent or more disability) at the time of registration.
- 26.6 Economically Weaker Section (EWS- Economically Weaker Section):- The benefit of 10 percent reservation for admission in educational institutions to the students of economically weaker general category is given by the General Administration Department's order number F-07-11/2019/A. Q./A, Bhopal dated 02 July 2019 and Commissioner of Higher Education's letter number 444/243/Aushi/Sh. Will be given in the sequence of 5'A' / 2019 Bhopal dated 15 July 2019.
- 26.7 NCC For applicants who have passed 'C' certificate, 1 percent of the sanctioned seats in the college will be reserved at the postgraduate level.
- 26.8 30 percent of the seats available in all classes will be reserved for girl students.
- 26.9 Madhya Pradesh Government, Higher Education Department and its subordinate government offices/universities, commissioner's office of higher education, regular working/retired/deceased officers and employees, principals, professors, librarians, sports officers, registrars and third and fourth class working in government colleges. 5 percent of the available seats in all concerned cadres will be reserved for children of employees.
- 26.10 If the percentage of reserved space is less than half then reserved space will not be available in the same category. Only if the percentage falls between half to one percent, the number of reserved seats will be considered one.
