for glass waste, the yellow dustbin is for plastic waste, the red dustbin is for metal waste, and the black dustbin is for organic waste.

• **Dry and Wet Waste:** Additionally, there are two dustbins specifically for dry and wet waste segregation, usually blue or green in color.

Processing of Kitchen Waste

SVCE will implement a kitchen waste processing system to convert kitchen waste into compost. This initiative aims to minimize organic waste sent to landfills, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and promote sustainable waste management practices.

Green Campus Initiatives

SVCE is actively engaged in green campus initiatives aimed at promoting sustainability and environmental awareness. These initiatives include:

- **Green Audits:** Conducting regular audits to assess practices and identify areas for improvement.
- **Plantation Drives:** Organizing annual plantation drives to increase greenery and biodiversity on campus.
