Gender Audit: An Introduction

A. Introduction of the Institution

Swami Vivekanand College of Engineering, Indore, is set up with the objective of making available facilities for higher education, research and training in various fields of Science, Technology, and management. It was established in 2004. The institute located at Indore, on Khandwa road in a campus extending over 25 acres amidst picturesque surroundings. The Post Graduate Programs offered by the Institute included MBA. MBA course is affiliated to DAVV, Indore. The undergraduate programmes are offered in Electronics and Communication, Computer Science, Information Technology, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical and Electronics Engineering Departments.


All Departments of the Institute have well equipped research laboratories and workshop facilities. In addition, there are a number of central facilities, which include Computer Centre, Central Library, Workshop, and Xerox Sections. The Central Library has a very large collection of books, back volumes of periodicals, standards specification and other literature. School of Management is very well constructed and designed Department Building spread in around 15000 sq. ft., providing such a wonderful studios environment and facilities with Computer room, Auditorium, Library Room and well-furnished Class Room for each subject.


The College prides itself by possessing a rare distinction of having a highly qualified, dedicated and enthusiastic staff with doctorates and professionally qualified. 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

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The Internal Gender Audit undertaken by the IQAC, Swami Vivekanand College of Engineering, Indore and internal Committee Members to scrutinize the gender balance within the institution and its practices and focused on the following objectives:


D. Objectives of the Internal Gender Audit exercise:


The following are the main objectives of the Gender Audit:

- a) To know about the gender balance in the college.
 - b) To know about gender perception in the campus.
 - c) To reflect and etch out a road map for gender action.
- To take effective measures for the safety and security of all genders.
 - To develop and enhance the self-confidence and self-esteem of girl students, women faculty and staff in the college.
 - To overall personality development programs shall be organized, which will develop confidence in the members of the institution.
 - To protect girl students from eve teasing and for the same posters to be exhibited at focal places in and around the college.
 - To certified consultant to be invited to take care of personal development and confidence building among students.
 - To join hands with IQAC, Anti-ragging Committee, and Discipline Committee and Women Grievance cell Committee for creation of gender sensitization.
 - To create social awareness about the problems of women and gender discrimination in particular.

An audit of gender sensitive features in the Institution yielded the following notable points:

- Basic sanitation facility in the form of separate toilets for the students and staff is provided in the common area. Separate toilets for male and female faculty are available.
- There is a Ladies Common Room provided on the Ground Floor of the main building.
- There are CCTV monitoring devices installed at different locations within the campus especially within the Library and major gates.
- There is a Women's Forum that conducts Gender Sensitization programmes regularly for the students.


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Gender Wise Distribution


A. Gender Balance within the Institution:


Gender Audit Team reviewed and analyzed the operating environment of Swami Vivekanand College of Engineering, Indore. From the analysis, the team understood that the college is operating in an environment where everyone has access to a full range of opportunities to achieve the social, psychological and physical benefits that come from participating and leading in sports and physical activity. Gender equity requires that girls and women be provided with a full range of activity and program choices that meet their needs, interests and experiences. Therefore, some activities may be the same as those offered to boys and men, some may be altered, and some may be altogether different. The college always concentrates on students' academic performance along with their overall personality development. Observing gender equality, the girls are provided with various facilities. The NCC unit for girls is meticulously developing their character and qualities like comradeship, discipline, leadership, secular outlook and spirit of adventure. This unit focuses on outstanding achievements of the girls. The lectures of eminent personalities are held on various topics to develop their personality. Workshops are held on 'Awareness program on Crime & Women/Girls Protection',

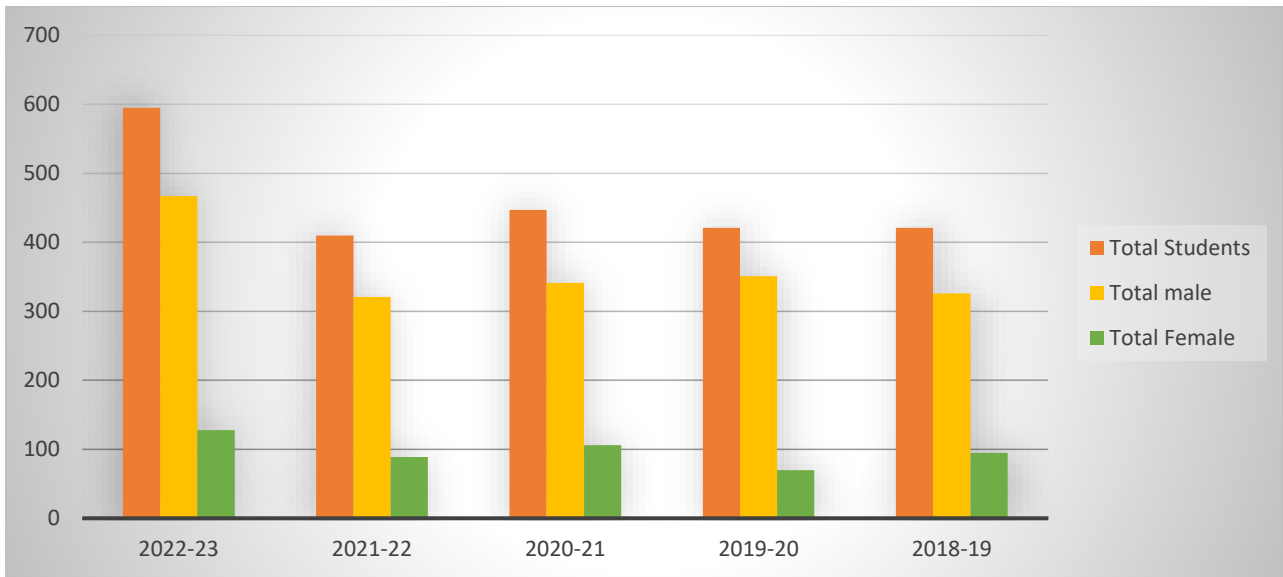

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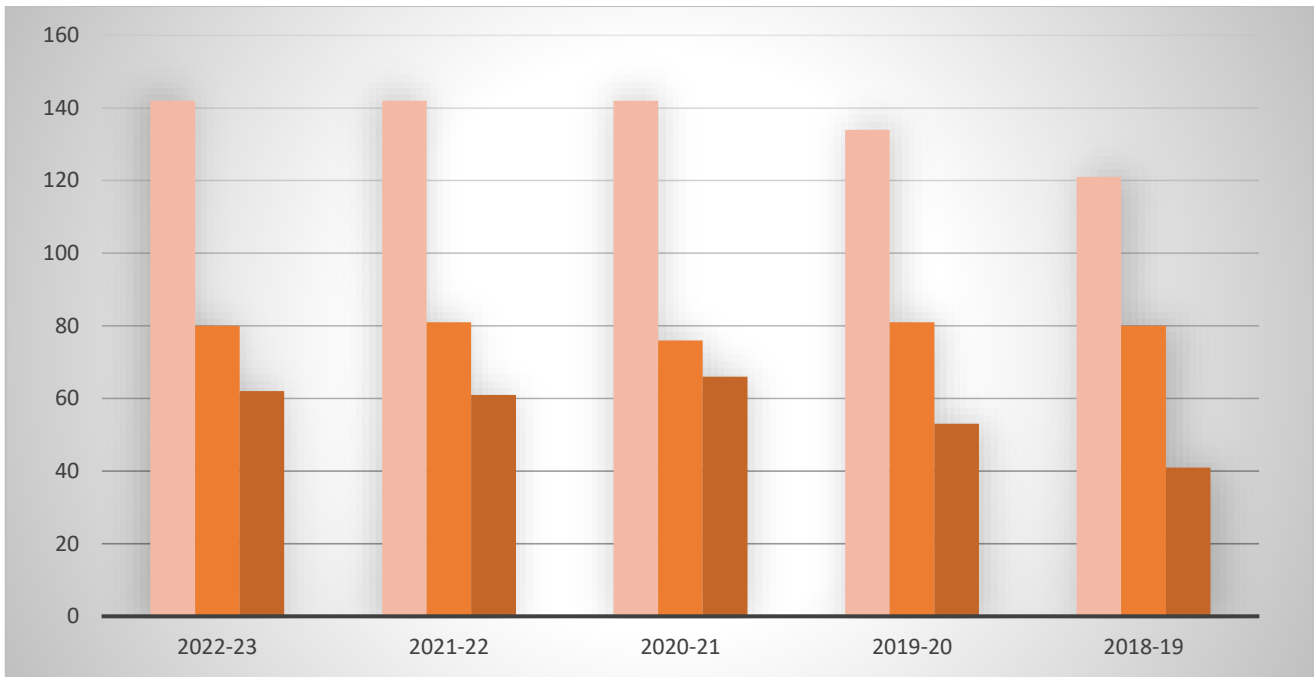

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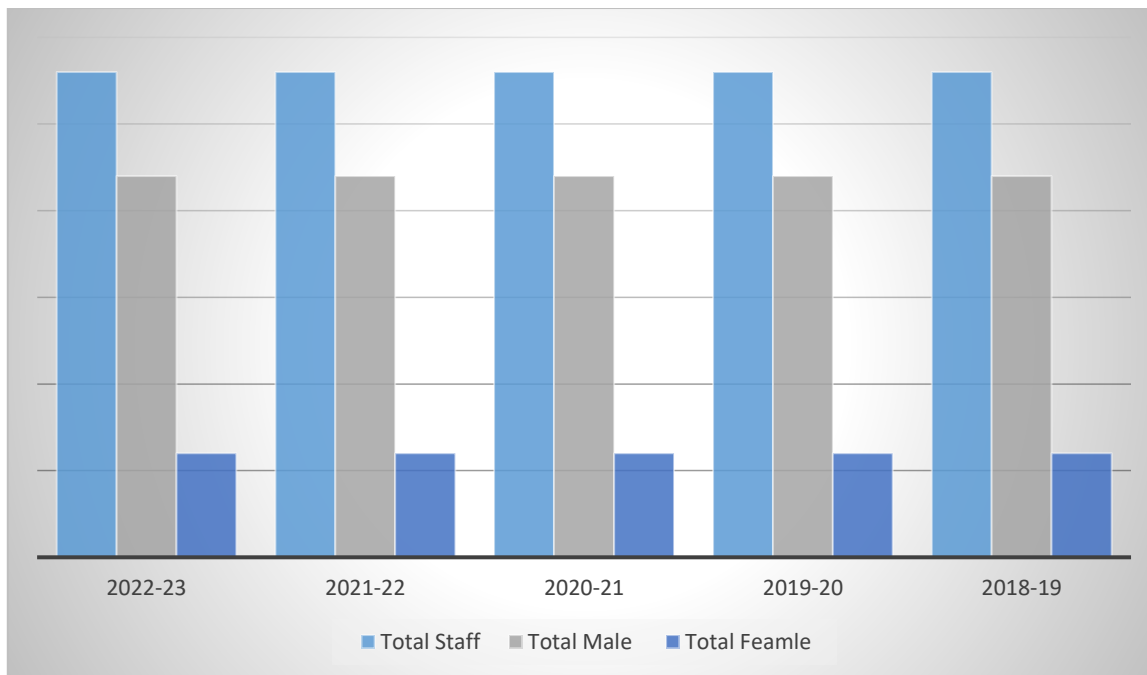

A. Progress towards Gender Equity



Gender equity means fairness of treatment for men and women according to their respective needs. This may include equal treatment or treatment that is different but which is considered equivalent in terms of rights, benefits, obligations, and opportunities.” –United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). The college constantly endeavors to work for the benefit of female staff and female students. The institution recognizes that women and men have different needs and power and that these differences should be identified and addressed in a manner that rectifies the imbalances between the sexes. This may include equal treatment, or treatment that is different but considered equivalent in terms of rights, benefits, obligations and opportunities.

We find that student's strength particularly girls' strength is increasing in both UG and PG programmes. We can see the differences in their enrolment also. More girls are enrolling for higher studies. Their strength is on the higher side. Further it has been observed that the success rate among girl students is more as compared to boys. They are taking interest in participating in all co- curricular and extra-curricular activities including cultural programmes organized by the institution. Their participation in sports is also commendable. In our institute we found that among regular teaching staff the strength of females is higher than that of males.

B. Conclusion:

The analysis shows that gender equity goals and objectives are included in all the policies, programmes of the college. The staff also reported that they have no problems related to gender criterion. Gender Audit Team analyzed that gender equality and gender sensitivity is encouraged by management and staff of the college and they do have gender sensitive behavior. It is found that the college has a lot of strengths and opportunities to develop good gender balance. The weaknesses can be overcome with gradual changes in value set up. Doubtless, the enrolment of girls from all sections of society is increasing and there are no gender issue complaints. With the strong will power and commitment to gender justice.

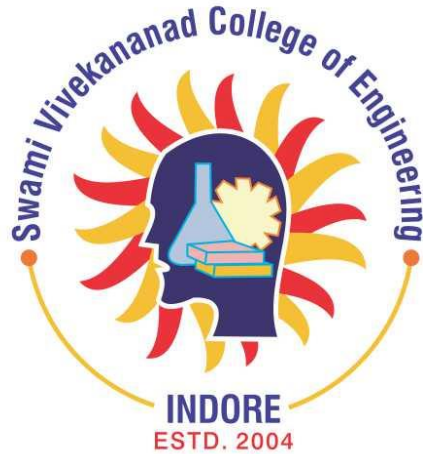

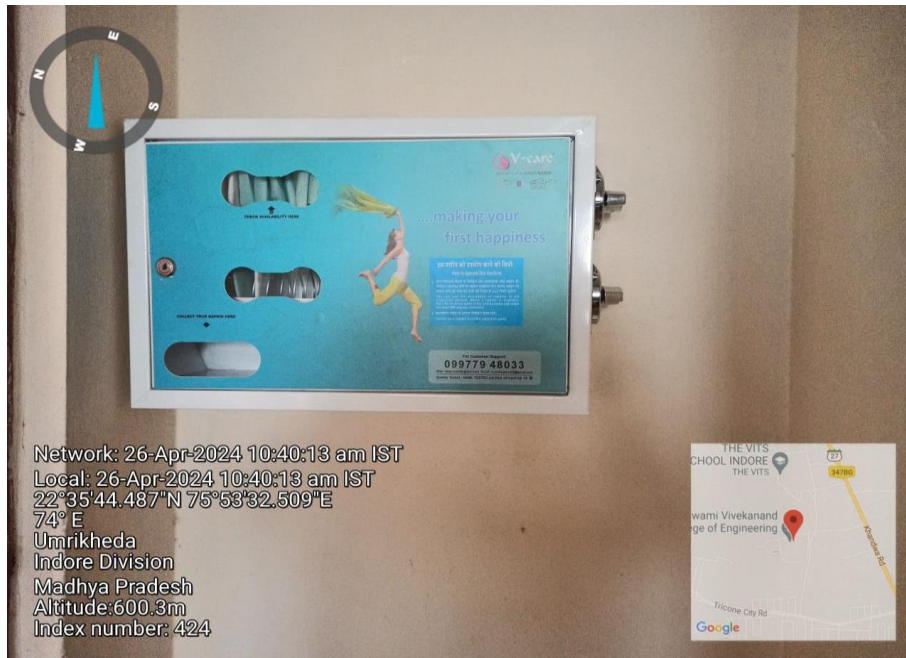



INTRODUCTION OF NCC
1 MP GIRLS BATTALION NCC, INDORE

1. The 'Aims' of the NCC laid out in 1988, have stood the test of time and continue to meet the requirements expected of it in the current socio-economic scenario of the country. The NCC aims at developing character, comradeship, discipline, a secular outlook, the spirit of adventure and ideals of selfless service amongst young citizens. Further, it aims at creating a pool of organized, trained and motivated youth with leadership qualities in all walks of life, who will serve the Nation regardless of which career they choose. Needless to say that the NCC also provides an environment conducive to motivating young Indians to join the armed forces.

2. NCC units strive to achieve the aims as spelt out by working closely with respective State Govt through local civil administration. Indore Group covers western part of MP training cadets in urban as well rural areas in various aspects of NCC. It is the earnest endeavor of NCC to reach as far and wide as possible to instill the ethos of "Unity & Discipline", terms which are foundation of NCC culture. However, it has been experienced that many a times, schools and colleges don't get to know the procedure to proceed ahead for introduction of NCC. Institutions are also not aware of nodal agencies to deal with on this subject.

3. The following steps have been listed out giving the guidelines and the procedure to introduce NCC in schools and colleges: -

(a) **Organisation of NCC.** NCC has different types of units, which differ on certain aspects of training. As far as the institutions are concerned, structure of sub unit which will function in the institution is as under: -

(i) Smallest sub unit/minimum strength which can be introduced in a school/colleges


(aa) For School - 50 cadets (half troop) and Multiples of 50


(ab) For College - 53 cadets (platoon) and multiple of 53

(ii) Girls Battalion of NCC can enroll only girls while other battalion can enroll boys and girls both.

(b) **Requirements from Institutions.** To introduce NCC, schools/colleges are required to provide the following: -

(i) Availability of willing permanent teachings staff to look after the NCC training. The nominated staff should be less than 40 years of age.


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- (ii) Availability of training ground for the parades.
- (iii) Rooms for store & office.
- (iv) Availability of (01) Miniature Firing Range for Cadets (desirable).
- (v) Availability of campus for conduct of NCC camp once in a year.
- (vi) Availability of Vehicle for Conveyance of Cadets for Trg purpose.
- (vii) Area to construct obstacle course.


(c) **Financial Implications**. Detailed expenditure on NCC activities is att as Annexure. The broad financial implications for Govt Institutions and Private Institutions are noted below:-

- (i) For government colleges and schools, entire expenditure will be borne by the state and central government.
- (ii) For private colleges and schools, entire expenditure will be borne by the respective colleges and schools.

4. School/College desirous of applying for introduction of NCC should interact with the unit for further coordination.

5. Once confirmation is received from the concerned institution, the Institution shall be provided with proforma of Enrolment forms for submission after filling all requisite details.
